MINUTES

TENTATIVE MILLAGE AND BUDGET HEARING
5:30 PM, Wednesday, September 9, 2015
Sebastian Inlet District Office
114 Sixth Avenue, Indialantic, FL 32903

Chairman Jenny Lawton Seal opened the hearing at 5:30 pm.

Present in addition to Chairman Jenny Lawton Seal were Vice Chairman Michael Rowland, Secretary/Treasurer Beth Mitchell, Commissioner Dave Pasley, Commissioner Ann Perry, Administrator Martin S. Smithson, District Staff Dave Kershaw and Nedra Maxwell, and District Legal Counsel Jack Kirschenbaum.

Chairman Jenny Lawton Seal announced that the specially called hearing was for the purpose of hearing public comment on the proposed tentative millage and budget of the Sebastian Inlet District for the fiscal year of 2015-2016. She noted that the current rollback rate for the District for the coming fiscal year of 2015-2016 is Ten point Six Nine cents (0.1069) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1069 of one mill) and that the District's proposed tentative millage rate for the coming fiscal year of 2015-2016 is Ten Point Six Nine Cents (0.1069) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1069 of one mill). She indicated that this represents a Zero Percent (0%) increase from the rollback rate.

District Legal Counsel Jack Kirschenbaum read before the Commission the complete Resolution 09.09.15-1 To Establish the Tentative Millage Rate in Brevard and Indian River Counties for Sebastian Inlet District for the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 of Ten Point Six Nine Cents (\$0.1069) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1069 of one mill), as attached.

Chairman Jenny Lawton Seal opened the public comment period for comment on the District's tentative proposed millage rate for the fiscal year 2015-2016 of Ten Point Six Nine Cents (\$0.1069) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1069 of one mill). As no public comment was offered, Chairman Lawton Seal closed that portion of the public hearing.

Commissioner Beth Mitchell moved and Commissioner Dave Pasley seconded a motion to accept Resolution 09.09.15-1 To Establish the Tentative Millage Rate in Brevard and Indian River Counties for Sebastian Inlet District for the fiscal year 2015-2016 of Ten Point Six Nine Cents (0.1069) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1069) of one mill), as attached. Chairman Lawton Seal called for the vote. The motion passed 5 to 0.

District Legal Counsel Jack Kirschenbaum read before the Commission the complete Tentative Budget Resolution 09.09.15-2 for The Fiscal Year 2015-2016 for the Sebastian Inlet District, as attached. The 2015 -2016 Budget represents a 21.7% increase from the 2014 – 2015 Budget.

Chairman Lawton Seal opened the public comment period for comment on the tentative budget for the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 of \$12,800,097 for the Sebastian Inlet District, as attached. There being no public comment offered, Chairman Lawton Seal closed that portion of the public hearing.

Commissioner Beth Mitchell moved and Commissioner Michael Rowland seconded a motion to accept the Tentative Budget Resolution 09.09.15-2 for the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 of \$12,800,097, for the Sebastian Inlet District, as attached. Chairman Jenny Lawton Seal called for the vote. The motion passed 5-0.

There being no further business before the commission, Chairman Lawton Seal adjourned the hearing at 5:47 pm.
