MINUTES

FINAL MILLAGE AND BUDGET HEARING
5:30 PM, Wednesday, September 19, 2012

Secretary/Treasurer Jenny Lawton Seal opened the hearing at 5:30 pm.

Present in addition to Secretary/Treasurer Jenny Lawton Seal were Commissioner Jeannette Westlake and Commissioner Ann Perry. Vice Chairman Culberson and Chairman Beth Michell were excused absent. Administrator Martin S. Smithson, Sr. Contracts and Accounting Manager Kathleen Knowles, and District Legal Counsel Jack Kirschenbaum were also present.

Commissioner Lawton Seal announced to the public that this specially called hearing was for the purpose of hearing public comment on the final millage and budget of the Sebastian Inlet District for the fiscal year of 2012-2013. She noted the current rollback rate of Eleven Point One Four Nine Cents (\$0.1149) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1149 of one mill) and that the District final millage rate for the coming fiscal year of 2012-2013 is Eleven Point Two Four Cents (\$0.1124) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1124 of one mill). She indicated that this represents a Two Point One Eight Per Cent (2.18%) decrease in the rollback rate over the 2012-2013 fiscal year.

Counsel Kirschenbaum read before the Commission the complete Resolution 9.19.12-1 to Establish the Final Millage Rate in Brevard and Indian River Counties for Sebastian Inlet District for the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 of Eleven Point Two Four Cents (\$0.1124) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1124 of one mill), as attached.

Commissioner Lawton Seal opened the public comment period for comment on the District's final millage rate for the fiscal year 2012-2013 of Eleven Point Two Four Cents (\$0.1124) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1124 of one mill). As no public comment was offered, Chairman Lawton Seal closed that portion of the public comment period.

Commissioner Westlake moved and Commissioner Perry seconded a motion to accept Resolution 9.19.12-1 To Establish the Final Millage Rate in Brevard and Indian River Counties for Sebastian Inlet District for the fiscal year 2012-2013 of Eleven Point Two Four Cents (\$0.1124) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1124 of one mill), as attached. Chairman Lawton Seal called for the vote. The motion passed 3- 0.

Counsel Kirschenbaum read before the Commission the complete Final Budget Resolution 9.19.12-2 for the fiscal year 2012-2013 for the Sebastian Inlet District, as attached.

Commissioner Lawton Seal opened the public comment period for comment on the final budget for the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 of \$13,030,332 for the Sebastian Inlet District, as attached. There being no public comment offered, Chairman Lawton Seal closed that portion of the public comment period.

Commissioner Perry moved and Commissioner Westlake seconded a motion to accept the Final Budget Resolution 9.19.12-2 for the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 of \$13,030,332 for the Sebastian Inlet District, as attached. Commissioner Lawton Seal called for the vote. The motion passed 3-0.

There being no further business before the commission, Commissioner Lawton Seal adjourned the hearing at 5:38 pm.
