**TENTATIVE MILLAGE AND BUDGET HEARING**  
**6:00 PM, Wednesday, September 11, 2013**  
**Sebastian Inlet State Park Fishing Museum**

*Chairman Beth Mitchell opened the hearing at 6:00 pm.*

*Present in addition to Chairman Beth Mitchell were Vice Chairman Jim Culberson, Secretary/Treasurer Jenny Lawton Seal, Commissioner Michael Rowland, Commissioner Ann Perry, Administrator Martin S. Smithson, District Staff Kathleen Knowles and Nedra Maxwell, and District Legal Counsel Jack Kirschenbaum.*

*Chairman Mitchell opened the public hearing.*

*District Legal Counsel Jack Kirschenbaum announced that the specially called hearing was for the purpose of hearing public comment on the proposed tentative millage and budget of the Sebastian Inlet District for the fiscal year of 2013-2014. He noted that the current rollback rate for the District for the coming fiscal year of 2013-2014 is Ten point Eight Nine cents (0.1089) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1089 of one mill) and that the District's proposed tentative millage rate for the coming fiscal year of 2013-2014 is Eleven Point Two Four Cents (0.1124) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1124 of one mill). He indicated that this represents a Three Point Two One Percent (3.21%) increase from the rollback rate.*

*District Legal Counsel Jack Kirschenbaum read before the Commission the complete Resolution 09.11.13-1 To Establish the Tentative Millage Rate in Brevard and Indian River Counties for Sebastian Inlet District for the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 of Eleven Point Two Four Cents (\$0.1124) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1124 of one mill), as attached.*

*Chairman Beth Mitchell opened the public comment period for comment on the District's tentative proposed millage rate for the fiscal year 2013-2014 of Eleven Point Two Four Cents (\$0.1124) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1124 of one mill). As no public comment was offered, Chairman Mitchell closed that portion of the public comment period.*


*Commissioner Jim Culberson moved and Commissioner Michael Rowland seconded a motion to accept Resolution 09.11.13-1 To Establish the Tentative Millage Rate in Brevard and Indian River Counties for Sebastian Inlet District for the fiscal year 2013- 2014 of Eleven Point Two Four Cents (0.1124) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation (.1124 of one mill), as attached. Chairman Beth Mitchell called for the vote. The motion passed 5 to 0.*

*District Legal Counsel Jack Kirschenbaum read before the Commission the complete Tentative Budget Resolution 09.11.13-2 for The Fiscal Year 2013-2014 for the Sebastian Inlet District, as attached. The 2013 -2014 Budget represents a 7% reduction from the 2012 – 2013 Budget.*

*Chairman Beth Mitchell opened the public comment period for comment on the tentative budget for the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 of \$12,106,082 for the Sebastian Inlet District, as attached. There being no public comment offered, Chairman Mitchell closed that portion of the public comment period.*

*Commissioner Jim Culberson moved and Commissioner Michael Rowland seconded a motion to accept the Tentative Budget Resolution 09.11.13-2 for the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 of \$12,106,082, for the Sebastian Inlet District, as attached. Chairman Beth Mitchell called for the vote. The motion passed 5-0.*
